WE MUST BAN FLY ASH DISPOSAL

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is considering new oversight of fly ash disposal that we must support. I have submitted testimony on this issue and took action to ban disposal in Anne Arundel County for the past three years. A new site is proposed for the border of Anne Arundel County and Baltimore. ► [World Trade Center Beams Installed at 9/11 Memorial](#)

It was a sight to behold on August 30th when the steel beams we received from the World Trade Center were finally installed at Police and Fire Headquarters. A team of a dozen local businesses, including LR Willson & Sons of Gambrills and Walnut Hill Landscaping of Annapolis, did the work at no cost to the taxpayers. We thank these patriotic citizens.

► [County Aids Annapolis by Paying Tax Revenue Early](#)

The County wired \$875,000 to the City of Annapolis to aid in closing the City's budget gap. About \$750,000 in property tax revenue was paid a month early, and \$125,000 in profits from the Eisenhower Golf Course was paid four months early. The fiscal impact to the County was minimal, less than \$500.

► [School Resource Officers Honored for Excellence](#)

Our School Resource Officers recently won the Exemplary School Safety Program Award from the School Safety Advocacy Council. One of my budgetary priorities approved by the County Council was to increase the number of officers in our middle schools. Across the County, we have officers in 20 middle and high schools that act as counselors as well as authority figures.
